

ISR 14 Registration, Required Forms, and Actions

There are up to four forms to be completed at this point and one website that must be accessed for electronic registration. ISR 13 is required to have signatures on forms.

Electronic Registration

ISR 14 will be using electronic registration and paper forms. The online registration is used for the access list to NSWCC Carderock for the ISR 14, a US Navy facility. There is still a need for paper submittal of medical forms and releases. Yes, this is a two part process. If you have mailed in your forms, you must still go to the website and register. The registration site (below) is hosted by the Office of Naval Research.

Website: <https://www.onlineregistrationcenter.com/ISR14>. This is not a public website. It is a secure website.

US Citizens.

Electronic Registration MUST be received by 19 May 2017 for entry. People Submittal after this date may be denied entry to the NSWCC Carderock.

PROOF OF IDENTITY.

A picture ID (e.g. US Driver's License) is required for entry to the NSWCC Carderock.

Non-US citizens.

Electronic Registration MUST be completed by 19 May 2017 for entry. Submittal after this date may be denied entry to the NSWCC Carderock.

PROOF OF IDENTITY.

A picture ID (e.g. driver's license) is required for entry to the NSWCC Carderock. A copy of your "Resident Alien Form" form is required for entry to the NSWCC Carderock if you are a Resident Alien.

CARDEROCK CAMERA PERMIT. (Part of the Electronic Registration above)

Requests for camera, phones with cameras, and laptop passes (still photography and video) MUST be received by 19 May 2017 via the on-line registration. Serial numbers are reported on the Carderock visit request form. Devices without prior requests will be surrendered for the day upon arrival at the NSWCC Carderock. NO EXCEPTIONS.

MEDICAL HISTORY - IMPORTANT NOTE: If you have any questions about a diver's ability to dive at the ISR™ due to their medical history, please contact the ISR™ Diving Supervisor well in advance. As we are working at a U.S. Naval facility, we are more conservative than many recreational training programs. All prospective racers/divers must have a clean bill of health, particularly with regards to pulmonary function and sinuses/ears. E-registration Instructions

The registration page is self-explanatory. You will be asked for name, address, place and date of birth and citizenship. The registration page will ask for team name and school affiliation. This information will be used to generate the access list and to process ISR 14 access badges to Carderock.

Remember me for next visit- check if you think you will return for another ONR event.

Submarine Name – TBD if you have not named your sub (It makes it harder for ISR if you have not decided on a name at this point).

Camera – Number of passes needed if you have a camera, video camera and/or cell phone with a camera. Number of passes needed if you have a laptop(s). N/A if you are not bringing a camera for each box. Cameras and laptops must be registered on Form 5.5.

Remember, the site will not accept your registration if you do not fill out all * information.

Paper Registration Instructions

There are up to three forms (5.2, 5.3, 5.4 and 5.5) below that must be mailed all completed forms, before their “Must be received” date to:
